

ORDINANCE 2008-22

AN ORDINANCE RE-NAMING THAT SECTION OF COUNTY ROAD 567 OVER THE SOUTH BRANCH OF THE RARITAN RIVER BETWEEN PLEASANT RUN ROAD IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BRANCBURG AND THE PORTION OF THAT ROAD KNOWN AS RIVER ROAD IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSBOROUGH.

WHEREAS, that section of County Road 567 over the South Branch of the Raritan River between Pleasant Run Road in the Township of Branchburg and the portion of that road known as River Road in the Township of Hillsborough was never formally named; and

WHEREAS, to satisfy 911 emergency response requirements, the road must be named by both the Township of Branchburg and the Township of Hillsborough; and

WHEREAS, the Somerset County Department of Public Works Traffic Safety Services Division recommended that because the total length of the formerly unnamed road is less than 3,000 feet and to avoid confusion in an emergency 911 response, both municipalities adopt a single name for this portion of County Road 567; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Hillsborough, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey now seeks to resolve any confusion and agrees that the re-naming of that portion of County Road 567 is appropriate for purposes of health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hillsborough and the Township of Branchburg have agreed upon the name Picket Place, selecting it from Hillsborough's standard list of historic names.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hillsborough, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That portion of County Road 567 over the South Branch of the Raritan River between Pleasant Run Road in the Township of Branchburg and the portion of that road known as River Road in the Township of Hillsborough shall be designated as Picket Place.
2. That the address for Block 9A, Lot 1 was 1111 County Road 567 (River Road) and is changed to 1 Picket Place.
3. The aforementioned roadway and its length and width is delineated on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A.

4. The within ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with law.
