

EXPLANATION: This Ordinance amends Sections 188-14H(2)(b) and 259-4B of the Code of the Township of Hillsborough to allow the posting of surety bonds for site improvements.

ORDINANCE 2009-12

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 188-14H(2)(b)
AND 259-4B OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
HILLSBOROUGH TO ALLOW THE POSTING OF
SURETY BONDS FOR SITE IMPROVEMENTS.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hillsborough, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, that Sections 188-14H(2)(b) and 259-4B of the Code of the Township of Hillsborough are hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 188-14H(2)(b), the third sentence, is hereby amended to add “or surety” between the phrase “the owner shall post a cash” and the word “bond.”

Section 2. Section 259-4B is hereby deleted and replaced with the following language:

- B. In addition to the above fee, the applicant shall also be required to deposit with the Director of Public Works cash, a certified check or a surety bond, payable to the Treasurer, Township of Hillsborough, in an amount in accordance with the following schedule:

Section 3. Subparagraphs (1) to (5) of Section 259-4B remain the same.

Section 4. Severability.

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
