THE DROP OFF SITE IS OPEN RAIN OR SHINE

ALL RESIDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

- APPLY FOR COUPONS AT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OFFICE.
- COUPONS CAN BE OBTAINED MONDAY TO FRIDAY FROM 7:00AM – 3:00PM.
- COUPONS WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM MARCH 1ST TO APRIL 30TH ONLY.
- 150 COUPONS PER DATE.
- FIRST COME/FIRST SERVE BASIS.
- ONE (1) COUPON PER HOUSEHOLD / YEAR.
- MUST SHOW PROOF OF RESIDENCY AND VEHICLE REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE TO BE USED.
- DUMP HOURS ARE FROM 7:00AM – 3:00PM.
- DUMP IS OPEN RAIN OR SHINE.
- RESIDENTS MUST PRESENT COUPON AT DUMP SITE (THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO THE DUMP SITE WITHOUT THE COUPON).
- CURBSIDE PICK UP IS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS ONLY (MUST BE 65 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER) WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF HILLSBOROUGH TOWNSHIP (REFER TO SENIOR CURBSIDE PICKUP RULES AND REGULATIONS).

- DIRECTIONS TO THE AUTEN ROAD DUMP SITE:
 - ADJACENT TO THE RAILROAD TRACKS ON AUTEN ROAD, NORTH OF TRIANGLE ROAD (NEAR AUTEN ROAD INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL).

THE PURPOSE OF CLEAN-UP DAY IS TO ALLOW RESIDENTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO DISPOSE OF OLD FURNITURE/TOYS/RUGS/APPLIANCES/BICYCLES/YARD CLEAN-UP BRUSH/HOT WATER TANKS/OLD FURNACES, ETC.

THE AUTEN ROAD SITE WILL BE OPEN ON THE FOLLOWING DATES:

1. MONTH OF APRIL: 2ND, 30TH
2. MONTH OF MAY: 7TH, 21ST
3. MONTH OF JUNE: 4TH, 25TH
4. MONTH OF JULY: 9TH, 30TH
5. MONTH OF AUGUST: 6TH, 27TH
6. MONTH OF SEPTEMBER: 10TH, 24TH
7. MONTH OF OCTOBER: 1ST, 29TH

PLEASE READ THE RESTRICTIONS CAREFULLY (RESTRICTIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS AND EXIST TO PREVENT ABUSE AND EXCESSIVE COST):

1. SMALL TRAILERS CAN BE USED (2000 LBS. G.V.W. MAXIMUM)
2. NO VEHICLES OVER 6,700 LBS. G.V.W.
3. NO HAZARDOUS/TOXIC MATERIALS (PESTICIDES/CHEMICALS/HERBACIDES/CREOSOTE)
4. NO RECYCLABLES (CARDBOARD/PLASTIC)
5. NO MOTOR OIL
6. NO BATTERIES/TIRES/VEHICLE PARTS
7. NO PROPANE TANKS
8. NO CONCRETE/BLACKTOP/BRICKS/PAVERS
9. NO LUMBER OVER 6 FEET LONG AND NO RENOVATION MATERIALS
10. NO TREE STUMPS OR LOGS OVER 4 INCHES IN DIAMETER
11. NO ELECTRONICS WILL BE ACCEPTED (FAXES, TVs/COMPUTERS/MONITORS, ETC.)
12. NO PAINT
13. FREON MUST BE REMOVED FROM ALL APPLIANCES
