## **ALL RESIDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO:**

- APPLY FOR TICKETS ONLINE OR AT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OFFICE.
- TO OBTAIN ONLINE TICKETS RESIDENTS MUST SEND PROOF OF RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS AND VEHICLE REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE THAT WILL BE USED TO DPW@HILLSBOROUGH-NJ.ORG. AN EMAIL CONTAINING AN ACCESS CODE AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING YOUR TICKET WILL BE SENT BACK TO YOU. MORE DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS ARE PROVIDED ON OUR WEBSITE. IN PERSON REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS ARE THE SAME AS ONLINE TICKETING AND YOUR TICKET WILL BE SENT VIA EMAIL.
- TICKETS CAN BE OBTAINED ANYTIME AFTER MARCH 1ST ONLINE OR MONDAY TO FRIDAY BETWEEN 7:00AM – 2:00PM.
- 150 COUPONS PER DATE. FIRST COME/FIRST SERVE.
- ONE (1) COUPON PER HOUSEHOLD / YEAR.
- DROP OFF HOURS ARE FROM 7:00AM 3:00PM.
- DROP OFF SITE IS OPEN RAIN OR SHINE.
- RESIDENTS MUST PRESENT TICKET AT THE AUTEN ROAD SITE EACH TIME THEY ENTER TO BE SCANNED (THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO THE SITE WITHOUT THE TICKET).
- CURBSIDE PICK UP IS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS ONLY (MUST BE 65 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER) WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF HILLSBOROUGH TOWNSHIP (REFER TO SENIOR CURBSIDE PICKUP RULES AND CONDITIONS).

- 4. NO RECYCLABLES (CARDBOARD / PLASTIC)
- 5. NO MOTOR OIL
- 6. NO BATTERIES / TIRES / VEHICLE PARTS
- 7. NO PROPANE TANKS
- 8. NO CONCRETE / BLACKTOP / BRICKS / PAVERS
- 9. NO LUMBER OVER 6 FEET LONG AND NO RENOVATION MATERIALS
- 10. NO TREE STUMPS OR LOGS OVER 6 INCHES IN DIAMETER
- 11. NO ELECTRONICS WILL BE ACCEPTED (FAXES / TVs / COMPUTERS / MONITORS / ETC.)
- 12. NO PAINT
- 13. REFRIGERANTS / FREON MUST BE REMOVED FROM ALL APPLIANCES
