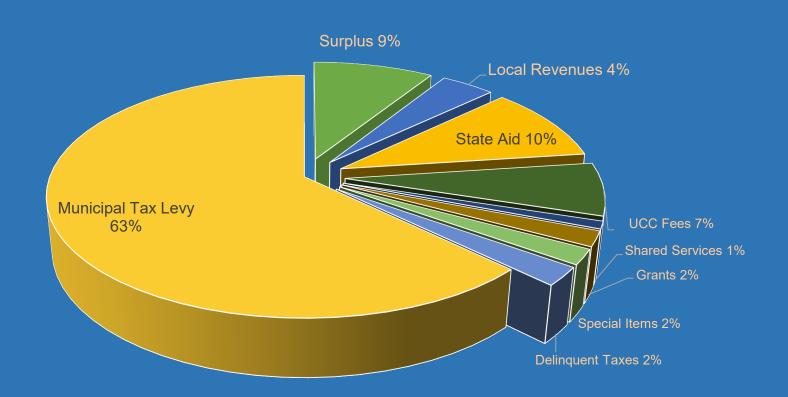
Total Ratable Value \$7,139,185,995

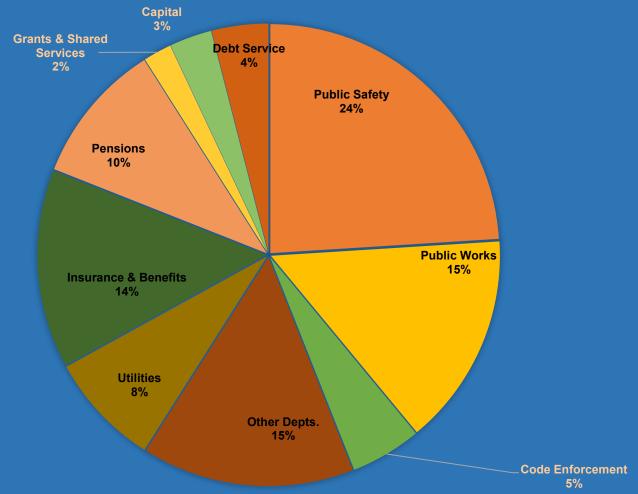

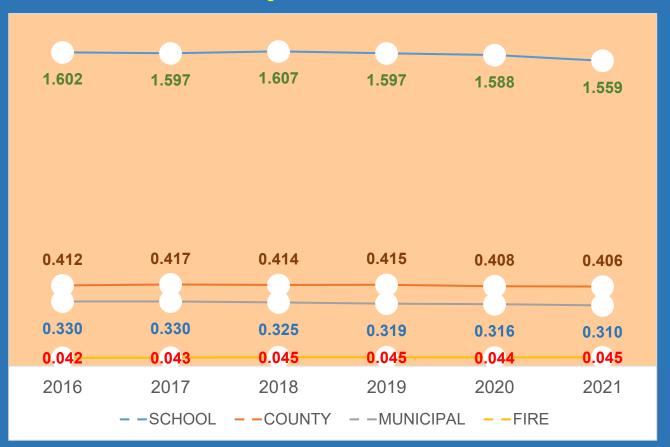
2022 MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS BREAKDOWN
