### **COVID-19 Hillsborough Reported Case Update**

The Hillsborough Township Health Department continues to monitor all cases and is working with the State to identify any potential contacts for follow-up. A representative from the Hillsborough Township Health Department will reach out to all individuals determined to have been in close contact with the positive testing persons within 24-48 hours of each case being confirmed.

#### <u>Health Officer Confirms First COVID-19 Related Death in Hillsborough</u> Township

<u>Hillsborough Township Health Officer, Siobhan Spano, has confirmed the first fatality related to COVID-19 in the Township.</u>

"I have been informed that one of our adult residents passed away due to complications associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. Our hearts go out to the family. Please know that you are in our thoughts and prayers, stated Mayor Doug Tomson.

"I have seen our residents working hard to adhere to the restrictions in order to help one another. I think that most of us realize that our actions affect our neighbors, and we are all doing our part to prevent the spread of this disease. I have faith that as a community we will continue to band together to protect our loved ones and neighbors", continued Mayor Tomson.

The Hillsborough Health Officer, Siobhan Spano, said "We continue to follow up on all reported cases of COVID 19 in Hillsborough Township and their contacts, in order to slow the spread of the disease.

## **Updates, Closures and Cancellations**

# Donations of Personal Protective Equipment Sought - Collection Site in Hillsborough

Supplies of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) are low due to the current public health crisis. - Face shields / Goggles
- N95 masks
- P100 masks / Air Purifying Respirators

Only unexpired items will be accepted.

A drop off location will be set up at the Somerset County Public Works Garage, located at 410 Roycefield Rd., Hillsborough 08844. Drop offs will be accepted between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m., starting Monday, March 23. Donations will be accepted through Friday, March 28.

All employees and volunteers working at the drop-off location will be practicing social distancing and maintaining a space of six feet or more. Donors are asked to observe the same precautions.
