Covid Booster Clinic Thursday, June 2nd

Hillsborough Municipal Building, 379 S Branch Road

Hillsborough Township Health Department & Green Brook Family Medicine will be providing:

- Pediatric Pfizer vaccines and boosters for ages 5-11 Booster is given 5 months after dose #2
- Pfizer vaccines and boosters for ages 12 and up
- Moderna vaccines and boosters for ages 18 and up

The vaccine is free of charge.



Pre-Register Online

- Please bring your insurance card to the clinic if you have insurance.
- Bring your COVID vaccine card if you are receiving a booster.
- A parent/guardian is required to be present with children under the age of 18.
- Dr. Cook will be available at the clinic to address any COVID vaccine-related questions.
