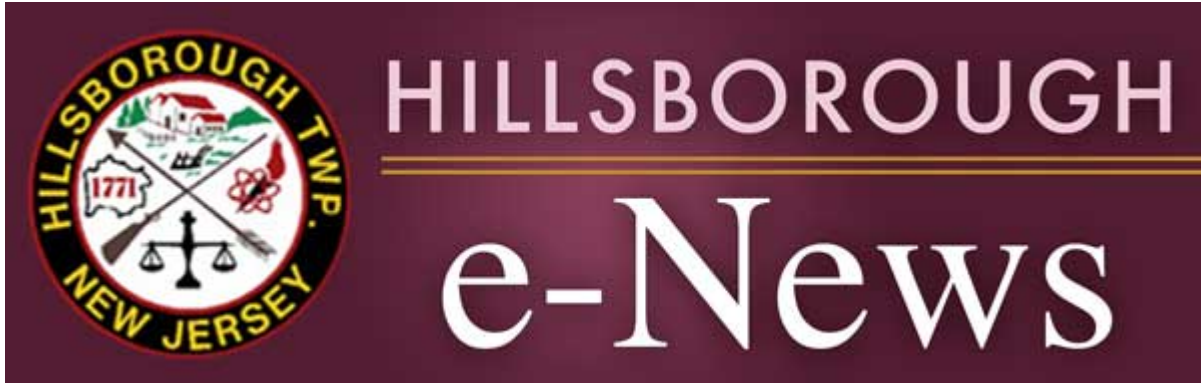

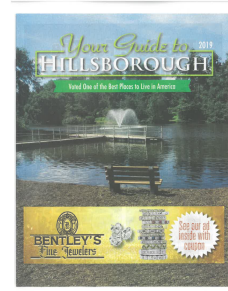

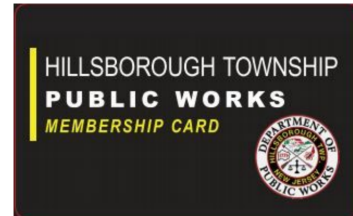

Spring Reins of Life Seeks 8 Veterans for Equine Therapy Program

Spring Reins of Life is seeking 8 Veterans to participate in an 8 week EAGALA Equine Therapy program set to begin September 5th.

The program will be held Tuesday and Thursday from 6:00 pm-7:30 pm. Transportation is not provided. Attendance commitment for all the sessions is important as space for each group is so limited.

Dates: September 5th, 10th, 12th, 17th, 19th, 24th, 26th, and Oct 1st.

Spring Reins of Life has been an approved EAGALA Military Services Provider since in 2014. They are the 1st and currently only program in New Jersey!

Requirements of veteran participants:

- US Veteran (does not have to be combat)
- Diagnosis OR Symptoms of PTSD *(does not have to be medically diagnosed)
- Self-Transportation to the farm
- Commitment to Attend 8 sessions (space is limited to eight veterans)
- Anonymous pre and post assessment surveys

Spring Reins of Life is certified by the Equine Assisted Growth and Learning Association, and also Military Service Providers since 2014. We do represent the state of New Jersey during this 15 state nationwide program under the [Eagala ASG VA funded grant](#) for the 2018-19 fiscal year.

Spring Reins of Life's OPERATION HORSE, an Equine Assisted Growth and Learning Association (Eagala) Military Services Designated Program Proudly Presents:
Equine Assisted Psychotherapy services for Veterans and Service Members suffering from trauma

Operation Horse (Spring Reins of Life 501c3) is currently recruiting Veterans to participate in a group equine mental health intervention aimed at treating trauma and the impacts of military service. Groups will consist of 6 participants, meeting weekly for 8 weeks for 90 minutes. These services are being provided by the VA Adaptive Sports Grant which was awarded to Eagala and is being administered through Eagala's Military Services partner organizations. There is no cost to U.S. Veterans and Service Members.
