

Township in Conjunction with the Somerset County Improvement Authority Purchases Over 330 Acres


Earlier this year, Hillsborough Township, in conjunction with the Somerset County Improvement Authority, closed on 335 acres of the property contiguous to both Mountain View Park and Ann Van Middlesworth Park, for a total of 724 acres encompassing all of these properties.

October 10, 2018, has been declared Put the Brakes on Fatalities Day. Traffic crashes in 2016 caused 37,461 fatalities. Those crashes caused over 2 million injuries and an average of 102 people died each day. That is one fatality every 14 minutes.

Building Department

Q: I've applied for a permit. How and when will I be notified when it is ready?

A: If you or your contractor have applied for a permit application with the Building Department, you will be notified when the application has been approved and is pending payment. Payment has to be made in order for the permit to become active. If the permit gets voided due to nonpayment, you will have to resubmit a new permit application. When taking out a Building Permit, please remember the Permit will remain open until all Final Inspections have been passed. Don't let open, unfiled, or unpaid permits hold you up if you plan on selling your home or business!

Engineering Department

Grant Money to Help Reduce Township's Cost of Road Paving The Engineering Department strives to save road paving dollars for the Township. The Engineering Department recently applied for 2019 New Jersey Department of Transportation local aid grant. Most grants awarded to a Township are for complete streets which are roadways with all means of transportation such as cars, bikes, and pedestrians. The Township Engineering Department has obtained grants for the Township most years which reduces the cost to local tax papers.

This year the Engineering Department submitted to NJDOT for a section of Willow Road between Amwell Road & Valinor Road as Phase 1. The balance of Willow Road will be additional phases in future years. By breaking the project into phases maximizes the amount of funding because the NJDOT will only pay up to approximately \$500,000.00 and phase 1 was estimated at approximately \$543,195.00. If awarded the actual road paving will not take place until Fall of 2019 or Spring of 2020 since the NJDOT awards are not granted till summer of 2019. The plans and specifications must be prepared and the project must be public bidded by the Township.

Finance Department The final tax bills have been mailed. For those property owners who were eligible the 4th quarter reflects the additional homestead benefit. If you have not received your tax bill please contact the Finance office and they will be happy to send you a copy.

<u>Health Department</u>

The Health Department has created a family emergency health plan using our **Family Emergency Health Information Form**. Make sure your family has up to date vaccinations and that a copy of the vaccination records are stapled to your medical information cards.

Also, the Hillsborough Health Department is still offering a limited number of FREE radon test kits to Hillsborough Township residents. Homeowners may contact Michael Carr at (908) 369-5652 with any questions. Interested residents can obtain a kit at the Health Department Monday-Friday between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm.

The Hillsborough Health Department was informed that a sick fox found on Woodfern Road on Friday, October 5 tested positive for rabies. If you were bitten, scratched, or had contact with saliva or central nervous system fluids of this animal, call your doctor immediately. Rabies is fatal unless treatment begins before symptoms appear. It was noted that the fox had been moved off the road. **Please contact the Health Department immediately at 908-369-5652 if you handled this animal.**
