# HHS Pride of Hillsborough Raider Marching Band Celebrates Successful Season

The Pride of Hillsborough Raider Marching Band competed at the US Bands Mid-Atlantic Regional competition on November 3, 2018, placing first in Preliminaries with a score of 97.4 and receiving the Caption Awards of Best Music and Best Overall Effect. The band advanced to Finals and scored first place with a score of 98.2125 and received Caption Awards for Best Music, Best Overall Effect and Best Percussion. They placed second overall at the State Championships winning Best Music and the Esprit de Corps Award for the highest music score of the competition.

Strokes are the leading cause of serious long-term disability and the fifth leading cause of death in the United States, killing about 130,000 people nationwide and 3,400 citizens of New Jersey each year.

Between 2012 and 2030 total direct annual stroke-related medical costs are expected to increase from \$71.55 billion to \$184.13 billion and overall, total annual costs are projected to increase to \$240.67 billion by 2030, an increase of 129 percent.

### **Turkey Basics: Safe Cooking**

Many variables can affect the roasting time of a whole turkey:

- A partially frozen turkey requires longer cooking.
- A stuffed turkey takes longer to cook.
- The oven may heat food unevenly.
- Temperature of the oven may be inaccurate.
- Dark roasting pans cook faster than shiny metals.
- The depth and size of the pan can reduce heat circulation to all areas of the turkey.
- The use of a foil tent for the entire time can slow cooking.
- Use of the roasting pan's lid speeds cooking.
- An oven cooking bag can accelerate cooking time.
- The rack position can have an effect on even cooking and heat circulation.
- A turkey or its pan may be too large for the oven, thus blocking heat circulation.

## **Department Updates**

### Building Department

Winterize Your Home

Autumn is here and Winter is just around the corner. Don't wait until it is too late to start winterizing your home. When water inside pipes freeze, it causes pressure inside the pipe, and when the pressure get too high, the pipe ruptures. We recommend to insulate pipes in crawl spaces to create warmth. Also, If you are planning on leaving for an extended period of time, do not shut your heat off completely.

#### **Engineering**

Engineering Inspections in the Winter Months The Engineering Department reminds residents that site inspections cannot be conducted if the area to be inspected is snow covered.

If additions, pole barns, garages, driveways, in ground swimming pools etc. are in the process of being constructed and a resident needs a final Engineering site inspection for certificate of occupancy it is recommended that the site work be completed before it becomes snow covered.

If the inspection needs to be delayed until spring, the Engineering Department requires that a cash escrow be submitted and a temporary certificate of occupancy be issued until the site work can be verified. Once the site work is verified, the cash escrow can be returned and a permanent certificate of occupancy can be issued.

### Finance Department

Dog License Renewal

The Finance Department will begin mailing out 2019 Dog License renewals in mid-December. Payments for these renewals cannot be made until January 2nd. Pet owners are reminded that, in order to renew your dog's license, their rabies vaccine must be valid through October 2019. Please watch the Township website for the date and time of the 2019 annual rabies clinic.

#### **Health Department**

November is Diabetes Awareness Month General Diabetes is a type of disease that is caused by problems with the hormone insulin. Insulin is in charge of controlling sugar levels in the body. Normally, an organ in the body releases insulin to help your body store the sugar from the food. Under diabetic conditions, the organ produces very little or no insulin and causes the body to malfunction. Another cause could be that the receptors in body cells do not recognize insulin. Approximately 30 million children and adults have diabetes in the United States.

Uncontrolled diabetes can cause many complications due to the high blood glucose, poor circulation, and damaged organs. The skin may take longer to heal, and feet can develop ulcers and infections. The eyes can be affected by early blindness. Kidneys may malfunction. Stroke and heart attack occur more often in diabetics as well. Nerves may also be affected and may be painful.

#### **Police**

During the Thanksgiving holiday weekend, the Hillsborough Police Department will be deploying supplemental patrols targeting impaired driving and other moving violations. Drivers are reminded to use public transportation, use a designated driver, or use one of the many paid services that are available.

#### **Public Works**

Leaf Program Information

Hillsborough Township provides both a <u>Leaf Pick Up</u> and a <u>Drop Off Program</u>, which runs from November 1st through the end of December. The Drop Off program is located at the Auten Road Facility. The purpose of this program is to assist residents with the removal of fallen leaves.

The Public Works Department urges residents to follow the instructions pertaining to the Leaf Collection Program posted on their website. It is against Township ordinance to place leaves in the street, and with the early arrival of winter weather, leaves piled in the street made snow removal extremely difficult. Plow drivers were not able to distinguish snow piles from leaf piles and inevitably the leaves were pushed all over the roadway and into the storm drains. Crews have now returned to the task of picking up leaves and will continue until all of the piles are removed.
