### **News From Hillsborough Board of Education**

### <u>Hillsborough Township Board of Education December 10, 2019 -</u> Referendum

The Board of Education unanimously voted on October 14, 2019, to hold a December 10, 2019, referendum on a \$35.4 million project to fund improvements to all Township schools. The state has agreed to contribute \$14.1 million toward the overall cost of the project.

This referendum – Repair, Replace, Revive – will address essential infrastructure issues that will benefit our students and staff by focusing on repairs, renovations, security, and indoor air quality concerns. The referendum will not include a new high school or full day kindergarten. Please take a moment to visit the district <u>website</u> for information about the referendum. The website includes <u>FAQs</u>, a <u>tax calculator</u>, an option to <u>submit questions</u> or <u>request a meeting</u> and a <u>list of community meetings</u> and facility tours.

Please take a moment to review the polling locations for the referendum. Some polling locations are consolidated for a special election.
