Understanding Your Tax Bill, the Reassessment Process and Your Reassessment Inspection

Your Tax Bill

Hillsborough Township mails out third quarter estimated tax bills in July of each year. This third quarter estimated bill reflects the current year assessed value of your property. In order to calculate your tax obligation, DO NOT take the third quarter amount and multiply it by four. That is not an accurate reflection of the total year taxes billed. [Read more.](#)



Reassessment Process and Your Reassessment Inspection

Hillsborough Township participates in an annual Reassessment program, which enables the Assessor to ensure a fair and equitable assessment of each property relative to the properties "true market value". SLF feeds on the plant sap of many different plants including grapevines, maples, black walnut, and other important plants in NJ. If you see SLF, help us stop it in its tracks! 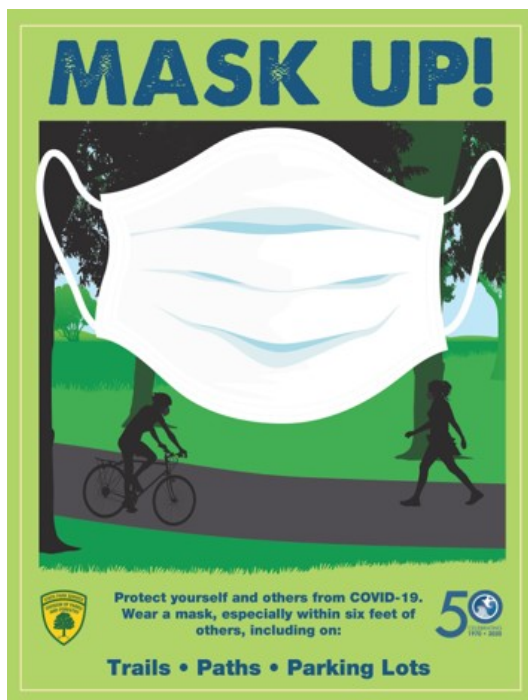
