Deputy Mayor Shawn Lipani Attends COVID-19 Memorial Ceremony at Bridgeway Care and Rehabilitation Center

On August 11th, a memorial ceremony was held at the Bridgeway Care and Rehabiliation Center to honor the 9 residents and 1 staff member that passed away from COVID-19. During the ceremony, Deputy Mayor Shawn Lipani had the opportunity to speak on behalf of the Township Committee.

"Today, we pause and remember those souls and we honor those who have been impacted by COVID-19, all of you - the frontline healthcare workers, who day in and day out experienced the devastation and sadness caused by the virus," said Deputy Mayor Lipani.

A tree was placed in front of the building courtesy of Central Jersey Nurseries and a plaque was placed next to the tree. The plaque was donated by the Pelligrino and Rivera-Dugenio families, owners of Bridgeway Senior Healthcare.

"May this living memorial be a reminder of your resiliency and your strength during these darkened days. Again, thank you for the opportunity to be with you all today, thank you for your dedication to our community and to the residents of Bridgeway," concluded Deputy Mayor Lipani.


