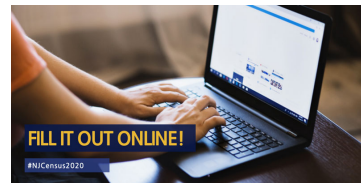
[Hillsborough Township and HEF Partner for Book Drive to Support Classroom Libraries](#)

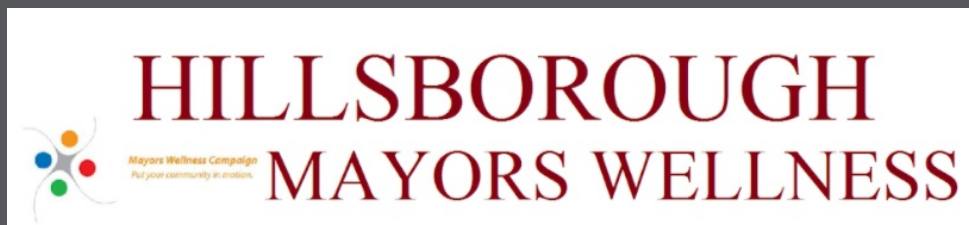
- Option 1: Families can provide a decorated "Trunk/Vehicle" as well as candy to hand out to the Trunk or Treaters.
