Building

 Reminder - please include your email address on your permit applications. Our automated system will send you updates on your permit status and will let you know when it is ready to be paid for.

Engineering - Correction from October 13th:

- All roads on the Township's 2020 repaving program have been completed except for Camplain Road, which was held off due to the PSE&G gas line replacement project.
- PSE&G is installing new gas lines on portions of Camplain Road, Triangle Road, South Triangle Road, New Amwell Road, Meadowbrook Drive and adjoining roads, and Lynn Court. These upgrades are mainly due to the upcoming, proposed widening of Route 206. The new gas lines along Route 206 will be larger in size allowing higher pressures on side roads and PSE&G decided to upgrade the other roads early this year to meet safety standards.
- The Township roads that were repaved a few years ago will be repaved by PSE&G depending on trenching and damage to the road, at no cost to the Township. The repaving of the Meadowbrook Drive area roads will be a shared cost by PSE&G and Township since PSE&G will only disturb half the road. Repaving of all roads will begin next year to allow our Engineering team to assess the settlement of the trenches.
