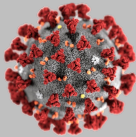

Grass and leaf drop off is held the third Friday of every month between 11 am - 3 pm.

Leaf Drop Off
Leaf drop off is held on the following dates and times in November and December.

The schedule for 2021 is as follows:
January 15th February 15th

July 15th August 20th
September 17th October 15th
November 15th December 17th

The following rules apply:
No brush, yard waste or debris will be accepted
Proof of residency required
Bagged leaves must be dumped and bags removed

Annual Cleanup Program
The Annual Cleanup drop-off for bulk items and brush is held the first and last Saturday of the month between April and October.
The hours are 7 am - 3 pm.

The following rules apply:
Registration is online on Community Pass. One (1) registration per resident household per year for bulk items and two (2) registrations for brush.
Hillsborough Township Residents ONLY.

Senior Curbside Program
This program is for Seniors Age 65 and Older ONLY. You may participate in the Senior Curbside program on the Drop Off Program, not both.
