Voting Information for the June 8th Primary Election



June 8, 2021 is the Primary Election. This election marks the return to pre-Covid voting procedures. **Polls open at 6 am and close at 8 pm for in-person voting.**

Some polling locations have changed, so please check your assigned location before you head out to the polls. You can find your polling location on your sample ballot or by visiting the NJ Elections Website. Polling locations for Hillsborough are also listed on the Voter Information page on the Hillsborough Township website.

If your polling location is in a school, please be aware of the drop off and pick up times for the schools as there will be increased traffic and you may experience delays. If possible, try scheduling your visit between 6 am -7 am or after 2 pm until the polls close at 8 pm.

Last year, all registered voters received a mail in ballot, but that is not the case for this election. Only those that requested a mail in ballot will receive one for this primary . If you received a mail in ballot you must vote via mail in ballot, and will not be permitted to use a voting machine.

Options for returning your mail in ballot:

- 1. Place it in the Dropbox located at the main entrance of the Peter J. Biondi Municipal Building, 379 South Branch Road, Hillsborough
- 2. Send it via USPS Mail (Must be postmarked by June 8, 2021)
- 3. Deliver it in person to the Somerset County Board of Elections
- 4. Mail in ballots will not be accepted at polling locations
