Updates from the Health Department

COVID cases and hospitalizations are rising quickly in Hillsborough and across New Jersey. Somerset County and our region are now at a High (Orange) level of COVID.

Here are some ways you can protect yourself, your family, and your community:

- Wear a mask indoors in public (including schools), even if you are vaccinated.
- Make sure you are up-to-date with your COVID vaccine and boosters.
- Get tested if you develop any symptoms, or if you are exposed to COVID. Have some home test kits available just in case.
- If you are at high risk for severe illness, avoid non-essential indoor activities. Ask others to wear a mask around you and/or get tested before seeing you.


