Fireworks Safety

In New Jersey legal fireworks include ground-based sparkling devices and novelties, such as sparklers and smoke devices including smoke balls, candles and cones.

Aerial consumer fireworks — including fireworks, sky rockets, bottle rockets and Roman candles, among others, are prohibited.

If you do use any LEGAL fireworks, please take the following precautions:

- Fireworks must be used away from structures, decks, wooded areas and mulch beds.
- Children may not use legal fireworks.
- Spent fireworks must be wetted or soaked in water before throwing them in the garbage.

Children Age 6 Months & Older Are Now Eligible For COVID-19 Vaccines

The CDC recommends that all children 6 months and older get a COVID-19 vaccine.

How can I participate?

- 1. Download the app (> 18 years-old)
- 2. Complete the consent form and enrollment questions
- 3. Log your daily activities, earn badges and explore the app!

What is in it for me?

- 1. Free reminder to check for ticks
- 2. Report a tick at any time and, during tick season, if you submit a picture we can identify your tick.
- 3. Check tick activity in your area!

Hillsborough Library Acquires IPad for Secure Access to Health Resources and Telemedicine Through NJ Health Connect @ Your Library

WHAT IS IT?

NJHealthConnect provides the community with access to apps and links to telemedicine sites for doctor appointments, multilingual health information, health resources, places for mental health support for adults and teens, the latest COVID updates, and crisis hotlines in New Jersey. Apps and links are preloaded onto a secure, private iPad provided by the NJ State Library.

WHY IS THIS AVAILABLE?

Telemedicine is a more affordable, portable, and convenient lifeline for people with or without medical insurance to connect with a doctor. It allows people to obtain an early-stage diagnosis, prevent illness, seek early treatment intervention, and obtain or renew medications so that health equity is within the grasp of everyone.

IS IT FREE?

There is no charge for patrons to use the iPads; however there are costs associated with telehealth appointments, and the costs vary by provider. Credit/debit cards are necessary for most telehealth apps.

IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE THE IPADS MAY BE USED FOR?

Absolutely! Some examples include:

Viewing wellness videos on YouTube or similar

Job skills webinars or library database access

Virtual job interviews

Looking up health information

CAN I RESERVE THE IPAD?

Yes! The iPad may be reserved for a specific date and time by emailing hillsboroughlibrary@sclibnj.org or calling the Adult Services desk at 908-458-8420, option 3. When not already reserved or in use, the iPad is available for drop-in usage; just visit the Adult Services desk and ask us.
